**PUBLIC PASSENGER OPERATORS TO ENSURE ORIGINAL COPIES OF ROAD LICENCES KEPT ABOARD THEIR VEHICLES**

The Transport Authority is **REMINDING** all public passenger vehicle operators that photocopies of road licences **WILL NOT BE** accepted by the Transport Authority Inspectors and Police during spot checks.

The Authority says there has been an increase in the number of attempts by some unscrupulous individuals to falsify photocopies of their road licences. Consequently, the Authority has increased its vigilance to ensure the legitimacy of the road licences being used by Operators Island wide.

In the meantime, the Authority is urging public passenger vehicle operators to ensure that they have the original copies of their road licences aboard their vehicles.
